Cambridge Saddle Club Rabies and Coggins Requirements

New York State (NYS) Origin Horses: All NYS origin horses on CSC (Cambridge Saddle Club) grounds must be accompanied by the following:

- 1. Rabies vaccination certificate (vaccination within 12 months prior to event)
- 2. Negative EIA (Coggins) test form, with the date of sample collection for the qualifying EIA test within 12 months prior to the event.

<u>Out of State Origin Horses</u>: All out of state origin horses on CSC (Cambridge Saddle Club) grounds must be accompanied by the following:

- 1. Rabies vaccination certificate (vaccination within 12 months prior to event)
- 2. A current interstate certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) with a negative EIA test, with the date of sample collection for the qualifying EIA test within 12 months prior to the event. Rabies vaccination information can be incorporated into the CVI.

NOTE - ALL HORSES:

To be accepted, all EIA (Coggins) Test papers (whether from NYS or Out of State) must have the "negative" designation, the date the test was administered, a complete description or picture of the horse, and the veterinarian's signature on the statement. A current rabies certificate is required. Proof of rabies vaccination must include the date vaccination was given, the name of the product used, and the veterinarian's signature on the statement. A separate veterinarian's signature is required for rabies if the vaccination information is contained on the EIA (Coggins) test certificate.

CSC follows NY State Ag and Markets Animal Health Requirements for NY State & County Fairs. You must have present with you the day of event/show documentation for the minimum information indicated by Ag and Markets for any horse on the CSC Grounds. (see https://agriculture.ny.gov/animals/horses-other-equidae for requirements). It is the SOLE responsibility of anyone with an equine on CSC grounds to be in adherence to NYS AG & Market Requirements and to be in possession of required documents. Any horse that exhibits signs of contagious conditions will be asked to leave the grounds immediately, at the discretion of the Show Manager(s).
